Dear Resident

In response to concerns raised by residents of West Hallowes about the speed, type and volume of traffic using West Hallowes as a cut through, the MRA has raised the matter with Greenwich Council on a number of occasions but with little or no response.

The latest suggestion was to make the last part of the road, between the service road and the A20 'No Entry' thus closing access to the A20 (although leaving the access from the A20 still open) with signs at the top of the service road and West Hallowes at the roundabout to indicate no access to the A20. The Council's response to this was that 'no-one has been killed yet' thus they do not intend to do anything; a very worrying view in my opinion.

Cllr John Hills suggested the Council may be more responsive to a petition thus we are canvassing the opinion of residents of West Hallowes and the Service Road to see whether they support the proposal outlined above and would appreciate you completing the section below and either posting it back to me or drop it through the letterbox of number 52 West Hallowes.

If the idea has enough support we will continue to put pressure on the Council to do something preferably **before** someone gets killed or injured.
